

Financial FAQ's:

Q: What if my circumstances change and cannot live on campus?

Cancellation request must be made in writing, prior to the start date of the lease contract. Application fees are non-refundable.

Q: What is included in the rental payment?

Rental payments include normal usage of utilities, basic cable, local phone service, voice mail, high speed internet connection, furnishings and use of all community amenities.

Q: How and when do I pay rent?

Rent is due at the first of every month. Rent may be paid with a check, money order, and cashier's check or SandDollar card to the Camden Miramar office. It is the resident's responsibility to pay rent on time. Reminders will not be sent out, and Camden Miramar does not accept responsibility for late mail.

Q: Do I pay rent with tuition at the University? It is the resident's responsibility to pay rent to Camden Miramar directly. Rent is due on the first of every month.

Q: What if I am on financial aid? If you receive financial aid, residents and applicants must submit a Housing Payment Option Request form each semester. This form is included in all application packets and it is available at the Camden Miramar office. Review the form for more information.

Q: What do I do when my lease is up?

If you are not renewing your lease, you will need to turn in a 30 day notice before departing Camden Miramar. To avoid extra charges, make sure to completely empty the apartment/residence hall of your belongings (leave the furnishings) and clean your apartment/residence hall before departure. You will need to turn in your keys before midnight on the last day of your lease.
